TREE PLANTING SPECIFICATIONS

The Bureau's goal is to preserve, protect, and renew the urban forest. Street Services encourages new plantings wherever possible and is ready to assist in all aspects of tree planting projects.

All trees permitted for planting in the public right-of-way require inspection prior to planting to confirm correct species, size, structure, and health.

The Bureau of Street Services requires that all new plantings adhere to the following specifications:

- Contact Small Tree section (213-485-6619) of the Urban Forestry Division prior to purchase and planting for tree inspection and tagging or assistance in locating specified tree species.
- Trees shall be a minimum 15-gallon size or as indicated on permit.
- Trees shall be installed with two ten-foot wood jodgepole tree stakes or its equivalent.
- Trees shall be secured to the stakes with two to four rubber tree ties in accordance with current arboricultural best management practices.
- Linear root control barriers shall be installed. The Bureau representative will assist you in the proper placement of the root control barriers.
- The permittee shall agree to maintain the tree for a five-year establishment period and replace if necessary (Sub-division or B-Permit work where fees have been paid does not apply).
- The permittee shall keep the soil around the tree moist by watering the tree with 10-20 gallons of water every five days for the first eight weeks after the tree is planted. Thereafter, the tree should be watered every twenty days with a minimum twenty gallons of water. (Watering requirements may increase/decrease depending on climate, season, and soil type.)

Tree locations should be designed with great care when Traffic Control signs may be affected. The recommended desirable distances between street trees are species specific and ranges from twenty-five to forty feet. The following is a list of the minimal tree planting distances between various infrastructures:

Water and Gas Meters	6 feet
Transit Shelters	10 feet
Driveway Aprons and Crosswalks	6 feet
Fire Hydrants	10 feet
Street Lights	20 feet
Electrical Power Poles	20 feet
Alley Entrances	20 feet
Intersections (45 feet from point of curb line intersect)	45 feet
Railroad Tracks	100 feet

During the course of excavation for tree planting, it is understood that the marked location for tree planting may need to be moved/adjusted and sometimes omitted. If marked locations fall below the parameters of the minimal planting distances, contact the Urban Forestry Division at (213) 485-5675. The Bureau looks forward to assisting and serving the communities' tree planting needs.
